- 4.111 may be taken in either the spring term of the freshman year or the fall term of the sophomore year. The earlier the better as it will allow for additional studios to be taken.
- 4.112 is also offered during IAP under the number 4.12A for students who take 4.111 in the fall of the sophomore year.
- For students who enter the major late, it is possible to substitute 4.116 with two subjects in Building Technology; Visual Arts; Computation; History of Architecture and Art; or Urban Planning discipline area (both subjects must be from the same area).

Keep in mind that a maximum of three subjects may be used to fulfill both Departmental requirements and GIR requirements. Generally, those three subjects are 4.205 (HASS elective), 4.605 (HASS-D) and 4.440 (REST).
